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MAXIMISEOPPORTUNITIES AND MINIMISERISKS FOR THE USE OF GENERATIVEAL IN EDUCATION

In its submission to theHouse of Representatives Standing Committee on Employment, Education and Training Inquiry into the use of generative artificial intelligence in the Australian education system Independent Schools Australia (ISA) has made seven recommendations to help to chart a safe and ethical path that maximise opportunities and minimises potential risks for schools.
